RE: SNHPC FY 2021 – 2024 TIP Administrative Modifications – November 2022

Dear Mr. Watson:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we have approved administrative modifications to the SNHPC FY 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). These administrative modifications were reviewed and approved under the expedited TIP revision procedures in the SNHPC Prospectus in response to a request made by your office, which was discussed during the Interagency Consultation meeting held on November 10, 2022.

Specifically, the SNHPC concurs with the revisions listed below for Fiscal Years 2021 through 2024.

- **Program (ADA)** – Changing the funding type for FY 2022 and 2024 CON phase work to better align with available federal funding.
- **Program (BRDG-T1/2-M&P)** – Changing the funding type for FY 2023 CON phase work to better align with available federal funding.
- **Program (BRDG-T3/4-M&P)** – Changing the funding type for FY 2023-2024 CON phase work to better align with available federal funding.
- **Program (HSIP)** – Decreasing FY 2023-2024 CON phase funding and FY 2024 OTHER phase funding to maintain fiscal constraint with available federal funding.
- **Program (PAVE-T2-RESURF)** – Changing the funding type for FY 2023-2024 CON phase work to better align with available federal funding.
- **Program (PVMRK)** – Increasing FY 2022 CON phase funding to match obligated funding.
- **Program (TA)** – Increasing FY 2023 PE phase funding to reflect anticipated expenditures. Changing the funding type for FY 2023-2024 PE, ROW, and CON phase work to better align with available federal funding.
- **Statewide (43931)** – Decreasing FY 2022 CON phase funding to reflect anticipated project expenditures.
