*The Currier & Ives Scenic Byway takes the traveler on a tour of quintessential New England. Along this route, you'll take in much of the rural and small-town charm that New Hampshire has to offer.*

**Come picture yourself this way!**

*Henniker* hosts the small college town feel with New England College and winter skiing and snowboarding at Pats Peak Ski Area.

*Hopkinton* lets you step back in time with colonial homes lining Main Street, shops in Contoocook Village, and two covered bridges.

*Warner* Main Street is the perfect place to visit after hiking Mt. Kearsarge or exploring the Mt. Kearsarge Indian Museum Educational and Cultural Center.

*Webster* is full of classic New England charm with early century farms, fields and sights. Kayak the famous Blackwater River and take a walk on the floodplains by Blackwater Dam.

Finally, end your byway experience in *Salisbury* with a visit to the Daniel Webster birthplace.
