a Special Committee to hold a hearing in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 230:45, RSA, to determine whether there is occasion for the laying out of the highway.

a Commission to purchase the land needed for the project if approved.


Upon said hearings held in the Bedford High School, after interested parties appeared, and having heard and read all of the evidence the Special Committee received, for the accommodation of the public there is occasion for the laying out of the highway petitioned for and the limitation of access.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION


This project will reconstruct and expand NH 101 to improve traffic operations and safety. The reconstruction of NH 101 will begin at Wallace Road and extend east approximately two miles to NH 114, and will widen the highway to provide two travel lanes both eastbound and westbound, a curbed center median, and sidewalks. The reconstruction will also entail improvements to the signalized intersections of Nashua Road, Meetinghouse Road, and Old Bedford Road/Constitution Drive.

This project will impact historic resources and wetlands.
