
BERLIN NH ROUTE 110 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The FHWA has determined that Alternative 4E, the Preferred Alternative, which will improve the conveyance of traffic through a 0.6 mile section of Route 110 in the town of Berlin, New Hampshire, will have no significant impact on the environment. This FONSI is based upon the attached Environmental Assessment/Final Section 4(f) Evaluation, dated April 2010, Public Hearing Transcripts, and Responses to Comments received which have been independently evaluated by the FHWA and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, environmental issues, and impacts of the proposed project and appropriate mitigation measures. It provides sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.
