The Commission appointed by the Governor and Executive Council on August 10, 2011, to determine if there is occasion for the laying out of proposed alterations of US 3 and Industrial Park Drive, will be meeting on Wednesday March 28, 2012, 2:00 PM at the NH Department of Transportation, 7 Hazen Drive, Conference rooms 112 and 113 in Concord, NH, to discuss the proposed project. This meeting is a public proceeding under RSA Chapter 91-A. The intent of the meeting is **not** to continue taking testimony as was done at the November 3, 2011 Public Hearing, but instead the meeting serves as a decision-making forum for the Hearing Commission. The public may observe the proceedings.

This project will be administered according to the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes to ensure nondiscrimination.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will reconstruct the intersection of US 3 and Industrial Park Drive to improve safety, and will rehabilitate a segment of US 3. The proposed intersection improvements will widen US 3 to provide a southbound right turn lane into Industrial Park Drive as well as a widened northbound bypass shoulder. The intersection improvements will include the reconstruction of US 3 extending approximately 0.2 miles south and 0.2 miles north of Industrial Park Drive and extending north approximately 0.8 miles to the intersection of NH 127.
