TO DISCUSS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF US ROUTE 202/NH ROUTE 9 WITH NH ROUTE 127 AND OLD CONCORD ROAD, IN THE TOWNS OF HOPKINTON AND HENNIKER.
