Public Informational Meeting Environmental Statement

The Department and its consultants are evaluating the project's impact on natural, cultural, and socioeconomic resources.

The primary resource in the project is Brackett Brook. The Department will continue to coordinate with the appropriate agencies to ensure that all impacts are minimized, and all permits are secured prior to construction. The need for stormwater treatment will be assessed as the project progresses.

Pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, the Department, in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration and NH Division of Historical Resources, must take into account the impacts of the project on historic resources. Potential historic resources can include structures over 50 years old, as well as archaeological sites. If anyone has any input on historic resources, please contact us. If anyone would like to take a more active role, the National Historic Preservation Act provides an opportunity for individuals or local officials to participate in projects as consulting parties.
