Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

- Reduce the number of fatal or serious injury crashes
- \$9 million per year
- Data-driven project selection
- “Modest” improvements

Existing Conditions



*Traffic volume: 10,000 vpd (NH 101)
2,000 vpd (sideroads)*

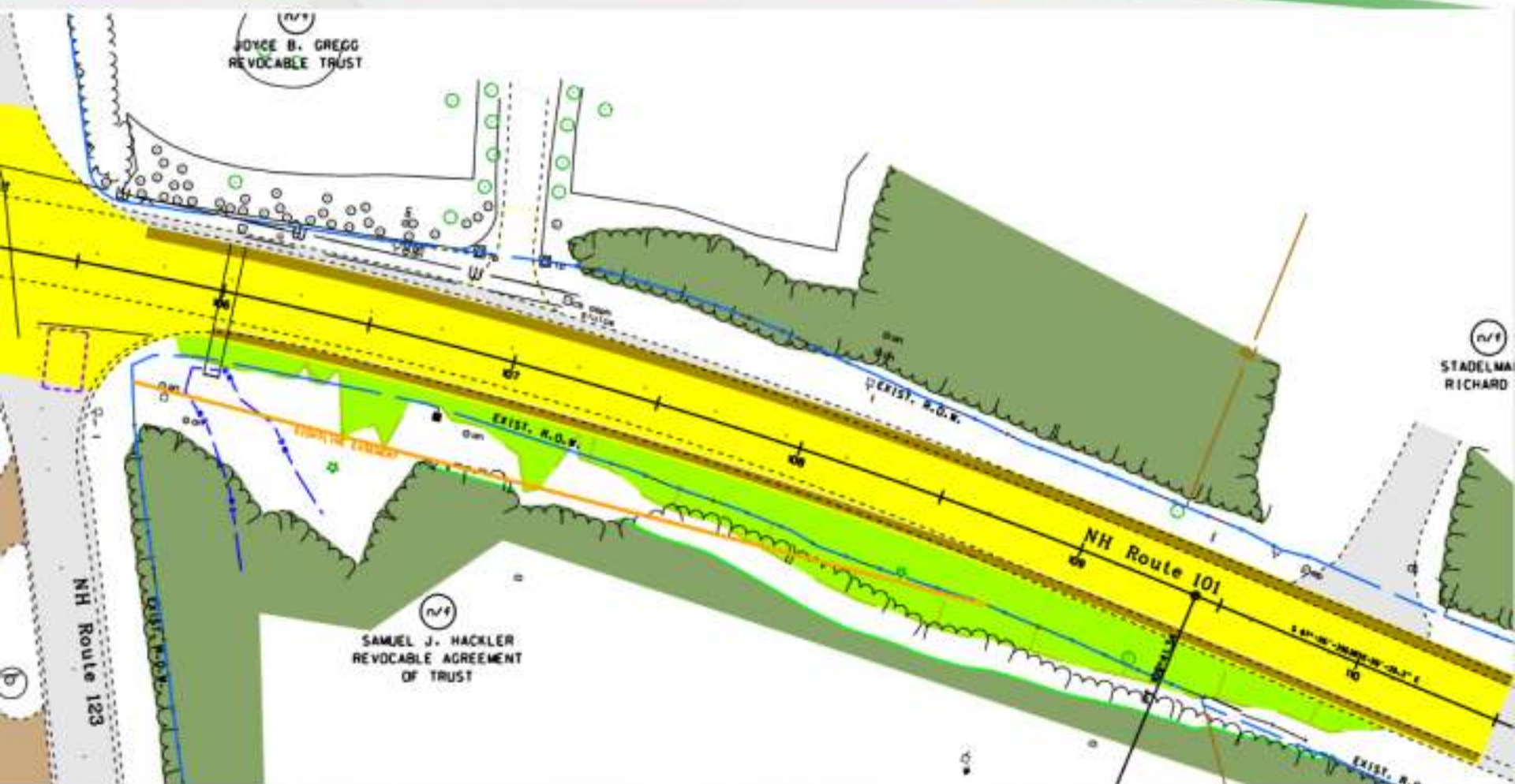
- Crashes 2005 – 2014*
- 14 w/ injuries, 30 PDO*
 - 28 failure to yield, 7 inattention*

Problems Identified

- Poor visibility looking east from both side roads
- High speeds, esp. NH 101 WB
- Poor intersection recognition

Proposed Improvements





Traffic Calming

- Range of alternatives
 - Islands
 - Special markings
 - Reduce width of road
 - Signs
