**Dillant-Hopkins Airport (Keene) - Airport Terminal Apron Rehabilitation**  
**Total Project Cost \$1.1M**

**Boire Field (Nashua) - Airport Terminal Apron Rehabilitation**  
**Total Project Cost \$2.5M**

**Laconia Municipal Airport (Gilford) - Airport Terminal Apron Rehabilitation**  
**Total project Cost \$1.0M**
