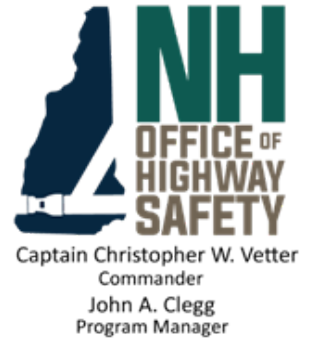

VIRTUAL LISTENING SESSIONS PLANNED FOR 2024 ANNUAL NH HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN

CONCORD, New Hampshire – The New Hampshire Office of Highway Safety (NHOHS) announces it will host a series of upcoming virtual listening sessions in an effort to gather community input regarding the 2024 Annual New Hampshire Highway Safety Plan (HSP).

The virtual listening sessions are part of the NHOHS's ongoing efforts to ensure that the plan is responsive to the needs and concerns of the residents of the State of New Hampshire.

The sessions, which will be held online and are open to the public, will provide a unique opportunity for participants to share thoughts and ideas on a range of topics related to highway safety, including distracted driving, impaired driving and pedestrian safety.
