 - From Parking Lot 1 and 2, you'll be just a short walk to **the correct entrance, The Franklin Pierce Center for Intellectual Property (at the intersection of Washington and Rumford streets, and No. 4 on the map).**
 - Once you've entered the building, you'll see a table with refreshments. Help yourself!
 - You'll also see a winding staircase to an upstairs balcony (an elevator also is available, just a few feet inside the lobby). We'll be hosting the event in Room 282, just upstairs. Please come and say hello at the registration table beforehand, and we'll make sure we've checked you off our list, given you a copy of the agenda, and allowed you the opportunity to sign up to make a public comment.
