ORDER

A hearing in the above matter was held on February 17, 2021. Following the presentation

of evidence, it was ordered that the record would be held open until March 5, 2021 to allow either

party to submit additional evidence or argument. On March 4, 2021, Enforcement Counsel submitted

supplemental evidence and Requested Findings of Fact and Rulings of Law. The supplemental

evidence addressed allegations that were not specifically included in the Order to Show Cause and

Notice of Hearing, but were related to the alleged violations. On the same day, Respondent

submitted a request to extend the closing of the record a few days because he was experiencing

computer troubles and would be unable to submit his additional documents prior to the deadline.

Respondent's motion to keep the record open is GRANTED. Additionally, in light of the

new evidence submitted by Enforcement Counsel, the Hearing Officer finds it is necessary to keep

the record open an additional 14 days to allow Respondent an opportunity to address and respond to

the new allegations. Respondent may also request an additional hearing. If Respondent would like

to appear for an additional hearing to address the new allegations and evidence, he must request a

hearing no later than March 15, 2020. Absent a request for additional hearing, the parties shall have

until March 19, 2020 to submit any additional documents, arguments, or objections.
