**Consent Order and Agreement**

This matter was commenced pursuant to an Order to Show Cause and Notice of Hearing dated June 12, 2007, wherein the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("Department") alleged that Paul D. Willson ("Respondent"), formerly a licensed non-resident producer, violated the insurance laws of the State of New Hampshire and the provisions of Consent Order and Agreement, INS No. 06-002-EP. The Order also notified the Respondent of the date, time and place of the hearing in which Respondent would have the opportunity to show cause why the Respondent should not be disciplined under RSA 402-J:12, V. In the belief that the parties were close to reaching an Agreement, this matter was continued. The following represents the sole Agreement before the parties for consideration and execution:

To resolve this matter, the Department and Respondent agree to the following:


1. The Respondent waives his right to a hearing in this matter.
2. The Respondent neither admits nor denies the truth of the facts and violations alleged in the Order to Show Cause and Notice of Hearing dated June 12, 2007.
3. The Respondent held a valid non-resident insurance license in New Hampshire from November 25, 1998 through June 14, 2002, such period includes all times relevant to this action.
4. The Respondent shall pay to Ms. Adele Russman, now Robertson, ("Complainant") the sum of Fourteen Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Five Dollars and forty-five cents (\$14,945.45). This amount shall become payable immediately upon the Respondent's execution of this Consent Order and Agreement. The check shall be drawn in the form of a money order or certified check and made payable to Adele Robertson. It shall be sent by certified mail to Ms. Robertson at the following address: 106 Front Street, Exeter, New Hampshire 03833-2625. On the same date, the respondent shall place in the mail or deliver to the Department, a copy of the check.
5. Should the Respondent fail to execute this Agreement and ensure delivery of the check to Adele Robertson by Friday, October 26, 2007, the Department's offer to resolve this matter shall be deemed withdrawn and the Department shall be free to commence administrative action forthwith. No other offer is before the Respondent.

6. Should the Respondent violate any provision of this Order once executed, the Commissioner, at his discretion, may bring an action in Superior Court to enforce this Order.

7. This Order shall be fully enforceable in the State of New Hampshire in any Superior Court convenient to the Department.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
