CONSENT ORDER AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Consent Order and Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") is made this 14th day of January 2013 between the New Hampshire Insurance Department ("NHID") and Mark P. Santos a New Hampshire non-resident insurance producer. *MPS*

WHEREAS, Mr. Santos is a licensed non-resident producer and as part of the licensing process he attested to the fact the he understood and would comply with the laws of New Hampshire.

WHEREAS, RSA 402-J:17, I requires that every licensed producer shall report any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction within 30 days of the final disposition of the matter.

WHEREAS, the states of Maine, South Dakota, Utah, Virginia, Washington and Kansas did take administrative action against Mr. Santos during the time period of July 2011 to September 2012.

WHEREAS, Mr. Santos did not report any of the other states administrative actions to the NHID as required by RSA 402-J:17, I.

WHEREAS, Mr. Santos admits that the facts recited above are true and accurate, and constitute separate violations of RSA 402-J:17, I.

WHEREFORE, for the purpose of resolving the above-referenced matter and in lieu of further administrative proceedings, the NHID and Mr. Santos have reached an agreement as follows:

- A. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted, incorporated and made a part of this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement.
- B. Mr. Santos admits to violating RSA 402-J:17, I.
- C. Mr. Santos' New Hampshire non-resident producer license shall be revoked, effective immediately upon the NHID's and Mr. Santos' execution of this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement.
- D. Mr. Santos waives his right to an adjudicatory hearing on the facts and allegation recited above.

E. By entering into this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement, the NHID and Mr. Santos intend to resolve all issues relating to the matters recited above, and this Consent Order and Settlement Agreement shall be deemed a full and final resolution of the allegations recited above.
