Subject: Special Data Call
New Hampshire Flood Losses

Since the flooding, New Hampshire Governor, John Lynch, has been touring the State and speaking with citizens. He has told me that there are concerns from a number of flood victims who are either unable to get through to their carrier or not having calls returned. I urge all of you to be as responsive as you possibly can and provide the best service available.

In order to fully understand and quantify the magnitude of insured and uninsured losses surrounding the recent flood event affecting many New Hampshire communities, I am directing all insurers, licensed by New Hampshire who write property and casualty insurance, to respond to a special data call. The data call consists of a series of five reports, due on various dates throughout the summer, and will provide the Department with information about claim count and loss dollars associated with this event.
