**NH Insurance Department Withdraws Bulletins for Regulated Entities**

**CONCORD, NH** – Commissioner Chris Nicolopoulos has withdrawn a series of bulletins from the New Hampshire Insurance Department’s website. “With the arrival of spring, we decided that it was time to clear out some old regulatory underbrush,” said Deputy Commissioner D.J. Our team has done a great job in this thorough review and it is our hope that by removing these bulletins it be easier for the industry and the public to better appreciate which policies are still in effect.”
