*Document Provides Information For Consumers Regarding Rental Car Coverage,  
Travel Insurance, and Health / Accidental Death Insurance*

**CONCORD, NH (July 22, 2022)** – Today, the New Hampshire Insurance Department (NHID) has released a consumer summer travel advisory for Granite Staters to consider before taking their summer trips or vacations.

“As summer is underway, we appreciate that Granite Staters are looking forward to their summer vacations,” said Deputy Commissioner DJ Bettencourt. “Our department has some important insurance considerations to ensure that the trip is memorable in a positive way and does not result in undue financial stress.”

This travel advisory has important information for consumers regarding rental car coverage, travel insurance, and health and accident insurance. The NHID urges consumers to review this document for helpful tips and information on common exclusions.
