New Hampshire Insurance Department Releases Winter Weather Consumer Advisory Document For Granite State Insurance Consumers

CONCORD, NH (December 13, 2022) – Today, the New Hampshire Insurance Department (NHID) has released a consumer advisory for Granite Staters to review their insurance policies with regard to the hazards of inclement weather.

"With winter underway in the Granite State, the New Hampshire Insurance Department is issuing a Consumer Advisory for residents as they manage the ice and snow that comes with the winter season," said Christopher Nicolopoulos, Commissioner of the New Hampshire Insurance Department. "Residents are strongly encouraged to review their insurance policies to determine the types of losses that are covered under their various policies."

This consumer advisory has important information for Granite Staters about understanding the coverage and limitations of their insurance policies. The NHID urges consumers to review this document for helpful tips and information.

"If residents have questions about their policies, we encourage you to call your insurance company, agent, or the New Hampshire Insurance Department's Consumer Services team to make sure you have the right types and amounts of coverage to protect your home," said Deputy Commissioner D.J.
