DECISION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

BACKGROUND AND STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES

The claimant asserts he is owed \$1,000.00 in unpaid wages for hours worked between April 12, 2014 and the end of May or beginning of June 2014. He worked as a night dump truck driver hauling asphalt at a rate of \$15.00 per hour. The employer paid him \$200 in cash. He is seeking a balance of \$1,000.00 for hours worked.

The employer agrees the claimant is due the claimed wages of \$1,000.00. He has been unable to pay because of personal issues.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The claimant provided credible testimony that he is due the claimed wages.

The employer agreed the claimant is due the wages.

The Hearing Officer finds the claimant proved by a preponderance of the evidence that he is due the claimed wages in the amount of \$1,000.00.

DECISION AND ORDER

Based on the testimony and evidence presented, as RSA 275:43 I requires that an employer pay all wages due an employee, and as this Department finds that the claimant proved by a preponderance of the evidence that he is owed the claimed wages, it is hereby ruled that the Wage Claim is valid in the amount of \$1,000.00.

The employer is hereby ordered to send a check to this Department, payable to [REDACTED], in the total of \$1,000.00, less any applicable taxes, within 20 days of the date of this Order.
