DECISION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

Nature of Dispute: RSA 275:43 I unpaid wages

Employer: NEHDS Logistics, 6 Research Dr, Bethel CT 06801

Date of Hearing: February 6, 2018

Case No.: 56483

BACKGROUND AND STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES

This hearing was consolidated with another against the same employer. Separate decisions have been issued for each case.

The claimant asserts he is owed \$750 in unpaid wages for hours worked.

The representative of NEHDS Logistics denies the claimant is their employee. He is an employee of R&V Moving LLC.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The claimant did not provided credible evidence he is an employee of NEHDS Logistics.

The representative of NEHDS Logistics provided credible testimony that the claimant is not their employee.

Therefore, the Hearing Officer finds the claimant failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence he is an employee of NEHDS Logistics and due the claimed wages.

He may have cause of action against another entity.

DECISION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented, as RSA 275:43 I requires that an employer pay all wages due an employee, and as this Department finds that the

claimant failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that he is owed the claimed wages, it is hereby ruled that the Wage Claim is invalid.
