Chapter Lab 600 governs safety programs and joint loss management committees. Part Lab 601 contains definitions, and Lab 603.03 specifies the duties and responsibilities of a joint loss management committee.

Lab 601.02 is being adopted to define the words "school district", "administrative unit", and "chartered public schools" as used in RSA 281-A:64, II & III.

Lab 603.03 is being readopted with amendment to provide requirements to ensure compliance with RSA 281-A:64, II & III as adopted by Chapter 38 of the Laws of 2020 (HB 1558), effective 09/27/2020. The changes to Lab 603.03(g) correspond to the changes in the law, which require "school districts", an "administrative unit", and "chartered public schools" to have provisions in their joint loss management committee plans for responding to violent acts committed by students against employees, volunteers, and visitors.
