Attorney Lehmann:

I am in receipt of your letter dated November 13, 2012. You have asked me to accept your letter as a Right-to-Know request for the immediate production of all records, meeting minutes, reports, documents, notes, drafts, tapes, email, voicemail, text messages, and other records pertaining to RFP 2012-14 – Warehouse Services for Wine and Spirits and Related Products.

I am concerned that your letter is outside the scope of RSA 91-A, and that responding to your request will constitute a violation of RSA 21-I:13-a, II as well as provisions in the RFP.

If your letter is determined to be a valid use of the Right-to-Know law, when and if a contract is finalized, we will forward the public portions of the contract to you as soon as they are made public. Before we can release any of the other four proposals (total of five proposals submitted), they must be reviewed by the vendor and any confidential information redacted. Once we receive the redacted proposals from each vendor, they will be forwarded to the Attorney General's office for review. Once that process is complete, these proposals can be forwarded to you.
