HEARING WAS HELD ON JUNE 9, 2021.

**“DECISION AND ORDER - DISCUSSION AND DISPOSITION:** Pursuant to RSA 178:2-a, temporary licenses shall be valid for the period specified in the license, which shall not exceed 90 days, and may not be renewed. During the temporary licensing period, the licensee committed violations of 178:20-a, 179:32 and 179:35.

“The director of licensing shall review each license application and submit to the commission a written recommendation on whether the license should be granted or denied. Upon deciding to grant or deny a license, the commission shall issue written findings stating its reasons for the decision.” N.H. RSA 178:3, IX-a. Here, the Division of Enforcement recommended the license be denied, and the Commissioners followed that recommendation. Letters were sent to the licensee on April 14 and 15, 2021 detailing the reasons for the denial of a license.

“Any applicant denied a license under this chapter shall be granted a hearing by the commission, upon the applicant's request.” N.H. RSA 178:3, X. Mr. Alarajy was given the opportunity for a hearing on June 9, 2021. During the hearing, he stipulated to the evidence and allegations presented by the Division of Enforcement.

“There shall be no presumption that any liquor license shall be renewed. The commission shall review all license requests for renewal, and shall not renew any license unless the licensee meets all of the current requirements for the issuance of a license. The commission may consider the licensee's record of violations, the manner in which the licensee has operated during the term of the license, the effect of the license on the neighborhood or community, and any other facts presented at the renewal hearing in determining whether to renew the license.” N.H. RSA 178:3, XI. In addition to the violations being a reason for denying the license, it was a temporary license which may not be renewed.

The hearing held on behalf of Babylon Hookah Lounge is in essence, an appeals hearing, conducted under the rules of the liquor commission. As such, it amounts to a review of the decision made by the Commission, considering all facts and law presented at the hearing. In the present case, the Division of Enforcement presented evidence that the licensee was issued a temporary license pursuant to RSA 178:2-a, which may not be renewed. Further, evidence was presented that the licensee violated RSA 178:20-a II, 179:32 and 179:35 during the temporary licensing period. The licensee failed to meet a minimum of 60% of its revenue through the sale of cigars and cigar related products, purchased supplies from unauthorized distributors on multiple occasions, and failed to retain all of its invoices. The licensee stipulated to all evidence and exhibits submitted by the commission. Due to the following, the Division of Enforcement determined the licensee would not be able to comply with Title XIII, and as such, the Commissioners denied the application for a liquor license.

I have no doubt the opening of a business during the COVID-19 pandemic was very challenging, nor do I doubt the testimony from Mr. Thomas and Ms. Noyes in support of Mr. Alarajy. However, no evidence was presented to refute the fact that Babylon Hookah Lounge was not able to comply with Title XIII during the temporary license period. Further, temporary licenses may not be renewed. The Commissioners were well within their authority to deny the issuance of a liquor license under the law, facts and circumstances of this case. As such, I will not overturn their decision.

**Penalty**

There shall be no penalties for the violations committed by Babylon Hookah Lounge. The decision of the Commission to deny Babylon Hookah Lounge a license is upheld.
