"DISCUSSION - DISPOSITION:

RSA 179:5 provides in pertinent part: "No licensee, salesperson, direct shipper, common carrier, delivery agent, nor any other person, shall sell or give away or cause or allow or procure to be sold, delivered, or given away any liquor or beverage to a person under the age of 21..." See NH Rev. Stat. Ann. 179:5, 1. The statute is one of strict liability, much like a violation of the state's speeding statute. It does not require a purposeful, knowing, reckless or a negligent mental state. Therefore, the purchase of alcohol to an underage individual is a violation of the statute regardless of the mental state of the person making the sale.

179:8 provides in pertinent part: "For the purposes of RSA 179:7, any person making the sale of beverages or liquor to any person whose age is in question shall require the purchaser to furnish any of the following documentation that such person is 21 years of age or over"... <u>See N.H. Rev. Stat. Ann. 179:8</u>. Like the sale of alcohol to an underage individual, failure to request proper identification is a violation of the statute regardless of the mental state of the person making the sale, although the fact of whether one's age is in question may vary among differing minds.

In the present case, it is uncontested that while under the age of 21, Ms. Sara Damboise entered Heaven's Food Mart on May 6, 2021 at approximately 5:01 P.M., and purchased a Natty Daddy, an alcoholic beverage, from Mr. Aniketh Nanganoori, an employee of Heaven's Food Mart, without being asked her age, or asked to provide proper identification.

The licensee argues that Ms. Damboise wearing a mask should be a defense to the violation of RSA 179:5 during a compliance check. He argues it is difficult to determine someone's age while wearing a mask. He testified that Ms. Damboise appeared well over the legal age to purchase alcohol. I do not consider Mr. Zaka's testimony about Ms. Damboise's appearance as he was not the one to make the sale. If Mr. Zaka wanted such testimony to be considered, he would have needed to call Aniketh Nanganoori as a witness and subject him to cross examination by the State. Furthermore, Ms. Damboise was only 18 years of age at the time of the compliance check, 3 years under the legal age to purchase alcohol. I agree with Mr. Zaka that it most certainly would be more difficult to determine an individual's age while they are wearing a mask. That, however, is not a defense to the statute. If anything, a licensee should be more vigilant in requiring identification from individuals wearing a mask when purchasing alcohol or tobacco products.

Further, licensees have been living with the COVID-19 pandemic since March of 2020, with on and off again mask requirements, and with many individuals still choosing to wear masks regardless of such mandates. The division of enforcement withheld from serving licensees with Notices of Agency Action for quite some time working with them to adjust to the pandemic, and these businesses have been open without restrictions for a sustained period of time. Finally, Heaven's Food Mart previously failed a compliance check on October 22, 2020, under a similar set of circumstances, was given a verbal warning, and assessed 4 points to the license without having to pay a fine. Mr. Zaka argues the penalty should be waived due to Ms. Damboise wearing a mask and his long history of being violation free. However, Heaven's Food Mart was given such relief during the previous violation, and the rule regarding penalties provides that the commission **"shall"** impose a fine of \$500 for a violation of 179:5 during a compliance check. See Liq 603.01(a)(6). As such, I have no discretion and must impose the fine.

Penalty

There shall be no additional points assessed on the license as the previous violation and assessment of points occurred within one calendar year of this violation. The licensee is ordered to pay a fine of \$500 to the Division of Enforcement & Licensing.
