**Permit Restrictions**

- Liquor manufacturers may ship up to 60 individual container of not more than one liter of liquor any consumer or consumer's address in New Hampshire in any calendar year. (RSA 178:27-b, II)
- Wine manufacturers may ship up to 12 9-liter individual container of not more than one liter of liquor any consumer or consumer's address in New Hampshire in any calendar year. (RSA 178:27-b, II)
- Beverage manufacturers may ship up to 27 gallons of beer, specialty beer or specialty beverage in individual containers of not more than one liter to any consumer's address in New Hampshire in any calendar year. Beer, specialty beer or specialty beverage shall not exceed 8 percent alcohol by volume. (RSA 178:27-b, II)
- Brewpub and nano-breweries may ship up to 27 gallons of beer in individual containers of not more than one liter to any consumer's address in New Hampshire in any calendar year. Beer, ty beer or specialty beverage shall not exceed 8 percent alcohol by volume. (RSA 178:27-b, II)
- All manufacturers holding a DTC shipping permit must file with the New Hampshire Liquor Commission on or before the 10th of the following month a DTC report showing all shipments of alcohol within New Hampshire with copies of invoices attached. (RSA 178:27-b, IV)
- All manufacturers holding a DTC shipping permit shall report all shipments under this permit on their monthly manufacturer's tax report.
- All shipments shall be made by a licensed carrier by the Commission. (FedEx Express, FedEx Ground and UPS)
- All consumers must be 21 years of age or older. (RSA 178:27-b, III)
- All packages must be clearly marked, "Alcoholic Beverages, adult signature (over 21 years of age) required". (RSA 178:27-b, III)
- Violations of this section shall be subject to the penalties of RSA 179:58
- No direct shipper may ship to a dry town.
