

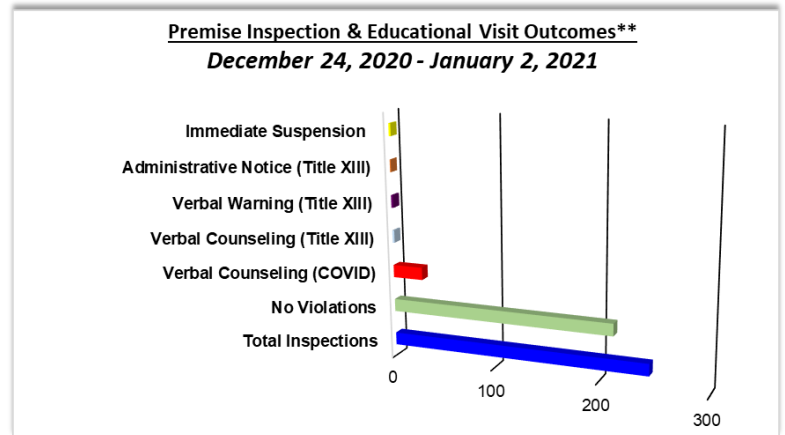
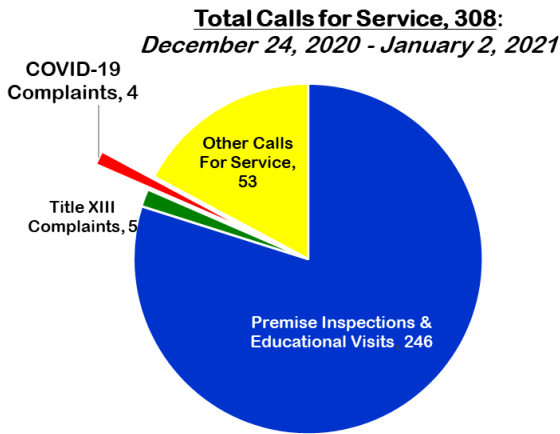

## December 24, 2020 - January 2, 2021 COVID-19 Enforcement and Education Summary

From December 24, 2020 - January 2, 2021 The New Hampshire Liquor Commission - Division of Enforcement generated three hundred and eight (308) calls for service.

- Of the three hundred and eight (308) calls for service generated from December 24, 2020 – January 2, 2021 the Division conducted two hundred and forty six (246) Premise Inspections/Educational Visits.
  - **Of these two hundred and forty six (246), two hundred and thirteen (213) resulted in no violations while twenty nine (29) resulted in verbal counseling for COVID-19 guideline related violations**
- The Division received four (4) complaints that reference violations of the COVID-19 Guidelines. Those complaints were assigned for investigation and have been, or are currently being investigated.
- **Two licensees received an immediate suspension in accordance with Liq 209.01, Immediate Suspensions with Hearing, for recurring violations of Emergency Order #52 – Exhibit B**
