


January 31, 2021 – February 6, 2021 COVID-19 Enforcement and Education Summary

- Of the four hundred and ninety two (492) calls for service generated from January 31, 2021 February 6, 2021***
 the Division conducted three hundred and eighty two (382) Premise Inspections/Educational Visits.
 - > Of these three hundred and eighty two (382), three hundred and forty two (342) resulted in no violations while fifteen (15) resulted in a verbal counseling for COVID-19 guideline related violations.
- The Division received four (4) complaints that reference violations of the COVID-19 Guidelines. These complaints were assigned for investigation and have been, or are currently being investigated.
- No licensees received an immediate suspension in accordance with Liq 209.01, Immediate Suspensions with Hearing, for recurring violations of Emergency Order #52 – Exhibit B
