



March 21, 2021 – March 27, 2021 COVID-19 Enforcement and Education Summary

From March 21, 2021 – March 27, 2021 The New Hampshire Liquor Commission - Division of Enforcement generated three hundred and sixty seven (367) calls for service.



- Of the three hundred and sixty seven (367) calls for service generated from March 21, 2021 March 27, 2021*** the Division conducted two hundred and three (203) Premise Inspections/Educational Visits.
 - Of these two hundred and three (203), one hundred and ninety (190) resulted in no violations while three (3) resulted in a verbal counseling for COVID-19 guideline related violations.
- The Division received zero (0) complaints that referenced violations of the COVID-19 Guidelines.
- No licensees received an immediate suspension in accordance with Liq 209.01, Immediate Suspensions with Hearing, for recurring violations of Emergency Order #52 Exhibit B
