



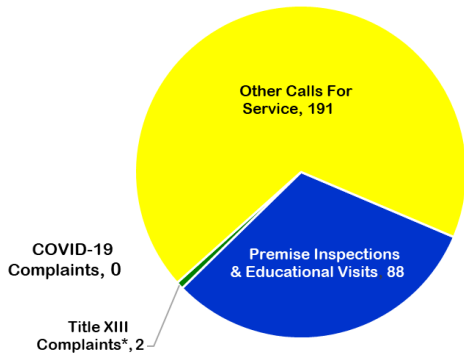

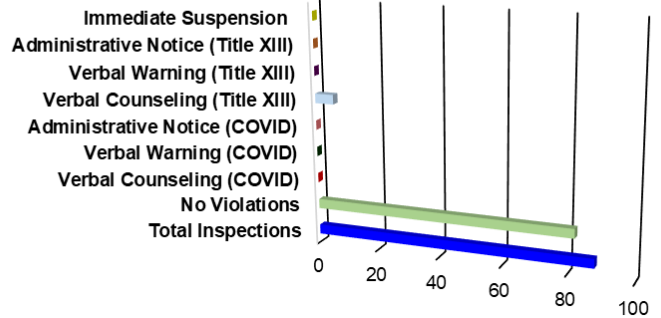
May 02, 2021 – May 07, 2021 COVID-19 Enforcement and Education Summary
