# Private Club Guidance for playing Pool & Darts

## 1. Purpose

The Division of Enforcement & Licensing has received inquiries regarding playing pool and darts in licensees designated as private clubs. The intent of this communication is to provide direction for all businesses licensed under RSA 178:22, V, h Veterans' Clubs, Private Clubs and Social Clubs regarding playing pool and darts on their licensed premises.

## 2. Discussion

All licensed Veterans' Clubs, Private Clubs and Social Clubs are authorized to play pool and darts on their premises; however, all licensees must still be in compliance with all other parameters of the Universal Guidelines in Emergency Order #52- Restaurant Guidance.

All clubs who engage in pool and dart activities must wear masks at all times while engaged in the activity and, as much as possible, remain six feet apart while playing these games. Pool tables and dart boards must be located at least six feet apart from each other so groups playing can remain 6 feet apart. Additionally, spectators must not be standing and observing these games. Spectators must remain in their seats and remain six feet away from the groups playing these games.
