1. Acknowledge that the applicant owns the plant and equipment. (initial)
2. Acknowledge that the applicant shall manufacture no more than 2500 barrels of beer annually. (initial)
3. Acknowledge that the applicant shall have all beers that they manufacture approved by the commission pursuant to RSA 179:33, I and II and Liq 506.09 prior to their sale. (initial)
4. Acknowledge that the applicant holds a basic permit issued by Tax and Trade Bureau and agrees to furnish copies of Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) production reports within ten (10) days of filing with the TTB. (initial)

5. Acknowledge that the applicant has no financial or other interest, direct or indirect, in any wholesale distributor licensee in the state. (initial)
6. Acknowledge that the applicant shall only sell in this state beers manufactured by them directly to the public for on-or off-premises consumption, self-distribution, to holders of wholesale distributor licenses pursuant to the provisions of RSA 180, or to out of state entities. (initial)
7. Acknowledge that prior to the 10th of the month, the applicant shall furnish reports to the commission, showing the quantity of beer manufactured and sold to, or returned from New Hampshire wholesalers during the previous month, as well as all fees required by RSA 178:26, I. (initial)
8. Acknowledge that the restaurant facilities of the brew pub meet the requirements for a full service restaurant. (initial)
9. Acknowledge that the applicant prepares, cooks, and serves the food for the restaurant. (initial)
10. Acknowledge that toilet facilities are available for the use of patrons meeting the requirements of RSA 143-A. (initial)
11. Acknowledge that at all times the business shall maintain a dining room or rooms with seating for at least 20 patrons and the kitchen facility can properly service at least 20 patrons. (initial)
12. Acknowledge that all liquor and beverages consumed on the premises shall be those sold by the licensee. (initial)
13. Acknowledge that any beer produced at a host brewery shall be included in the brew pub's production limit. (initial)
14. Acknowledge that the applicant shall pay \$0.30 per gallon on all beer produced. (initial)

By initialing this statement I, _____ certify that I will retain, maintain, and keep readily available all supporting documentation as required per this license worksheet. If requested, I agree to provide such documentation to any member of the NHLC. (initial)

Individuals, partnerships, limited liability companies and partnerships, or corporations but not to unincorporated associations, to apply for the manufacture, warehousing, sale, offer for sale, or solicitation of orders for sale of liquor or beverages and for retail sales of tobacco products within the state, subject to the limitations and restrictions imposed by RSA 178:2.

WHAT IS THE FEE

The annual brew pub license fee is \$1,200.00 pursuant to RSA 178:29, III, (a)(1).

Incomplete license type requirement form will be returned to the applicant and will result in a delay in issuance of a license. Some common omissions/errors include:

- The application for license is not attached. (This does not apply for renewals.)
- Check missing or not filled-out completely or signed.
- License type requirement form is not properly complete or unsigned.

RSA 175:1, XII-a Definition:

"Brew pub" means a manufacturer of beer, specialty beer, or cider not exceeding 2,500 barrels annually, which as a functional part of its business, maintains a full service restaurant serving the beer it manufactures as well as other beverage and liquor as allowed by RSA 178:21, II(a)(1) and RSA 178:22, V(q).
