1. Acknowledge that no principal of a beverage manufacturer, brewpub, beverage vendor, liquor and wine vendor, liquor and wine representative, liquor manufacturer, rectifier, wine manufacturer, on-premises or off-premises has any interest in this business. (initial)
2. Acknowledge that all beverages will only be purchased from New Hampshire licensed beverage vendors, beverage manufacturers, brewpubs, nano-brewery or wholesaler distributors. (initial)
3. Acknowledge that applicant shall furnish, on or before the 10th of the month, certain sales information required for tax purposes as specified in Liq 506:10. _____ (initial)
4. Acknowledge that the applicant shall post a bond with the Commission as required by RSA 178:16, II and Liq 704.04. (initial)
5. Acknowledge that the applicant and persons in his/her employment shall carry a copy of this license while conducting business for the wholesaler and also in all vehicles engaged in the transportation of beverages. (initial)
6. Acknowledge that sales under the off-premises provisions of the wholesale license shall be limited to the licensed premises. (initial)
7. Acknowledge that applicant shall not deliver beverages in less than 9 liter case lots. _____ (initial)

By initialing this statement, I, _____ certify that I will retain, maintain, and keep readily available all supporting documentation as required per this license worksheet. If requested, I agree to provide such documentation to any member of the NHLC. (initial)

Individuals, partnerships, limited liability companies and partnerships, or corporations but not to unincorporated associations, to apply for the manufacture, warehousing, sale, offer for sale, or solicitation of orders for sale of liquor or beverages and for retail sales of tobacco products within the state, subject to the limitations and restrictions imposed by RSA 178:2.

WHAT IS THE FEE:

The fee for this license is \$2,500 pursuant to RSA 178:29, III (c).

Incomplete license type requirement form will be returned to the applicant and will result in a delay in issuance of a license. Some common omissions/errors include:

- The application for license is not attached. (This does not apply for renewals.)
- Check missing or not filled-out completely or signed.
- License type worksheet form is not properly complete or unsigned.

RSA 175:1, LXVI Definition:

"Wholesale distributor" means a person licensed by the commission to engage in the purchase of beverages only from the holders of wholesale distributor licenses, beverage manufacturer licenses, beverage vendor licenses, brew pub licenses, or nano brewery licenses. Wholesale distributors may resell, to other licensees, beverages in their original containers, as prepared for the market by the manufacturer, but not for consumption, except for tasting on the premises of the wholesaler.
