**VOLUNTARY PERMANENT SURRENDER OF LICENSE**

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board"), I, Lloyd Kasper, M.D., hereby voluntarily and permanently surrender my New Hampshire medical license (No. 6205) effective on the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary permanent surrender of license.

By voluntarily permanently surrendering my license, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice medicine in the State of New Hampshire effective upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary permanent surrender of license.
2. I admit that this voluntary permanent surrender of license is occurring following the Board's commencement of an investigation into me pursuant to RSA 329:18, and to resolve the pending misconduct allegations that I:
  - (a) Failed to ensure that communication protocols and systems in connection with certain drug trials were sufficient and were being followed to fully address clinical care and patient oversight;

(b) Engaged in improper and disruptive behavior in the presence of staff in the workplace by exhibiting a loss of temper;

(c) Did not take appropriate remedial action to resolve conflicts between the nursing director and other clinical trial staff, after it was reported that the nursing director had engaged in improper and disruptive behavior towards her subordinates, in part because of my personal relationship with the nursing director;

(d) Was absent from campus during the course of certain drug trials without sufficient prior notification or approval, resulting at times in an unavailability to respond to concerns and an inability to timely carry out required duties; and

(e) Failed to completely and accurately answer two questions in my 2012 license renewal application filed with the Board.


3. I admit to no violations of any statutes, code of conduct provisions, rules or regulations, including, but not limited to, RSA 318:17, VI; and I deny the allegations set forth above in paragraphs 2 (a) through (e). I recognize that this voluntary permanent surrender of license, upon its acceptance, will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action as set forth below.
4. I understand that this document constitutes a voluntary *permanent* surrender of my license, and as such, I will not be eligible to become licensed again by the Board.

5. While I submit that I will not again seek licensure by this Board, I understand that in the event that I ever do submit a licensure application, the Board may deny such application solely on the basis of this voluntary permanent surrender of license. In the event that the Board does not deny such application on that basis, I understand that the above pending misconduct allegations shall be resolved in any such future licensure application process before the Board, and that I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to the above pending misconduct allegations. While a notice of hearing has not been issued in this matter, all of my defenses are fully preserved.
6. I understand that upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary permanent surrender of license, this document shall be distributed as disciplinary action to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decision making a specific finding of professional misconduct. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
7. I acknowledge that while this voluntary permanent surrender of license does not prohibit me from continuing to conduct and secure funding for research, or teaching and consulting in the medical and scientific fields in which my career has focused, it does prohibit me from providing any direct patient care and supervising any individual who is providing direct patient care.

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8. I freely submit this voluntary permanent surrender of license to the Board solely in an effort to resolve this matter and I confirm that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
9. I confirm that I have read and understand this voluntary permanent surrender of license and that I was not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at the time that I read and signed it.
10. I confirm that I have had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of my choosing in connection with my decision to sign this voluntary permanent surrender of license.


