VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board") concerning an incident in which I, Kevin M. Kendall, MD, hereby voluntarily surrender my New Hampshire license (#10774) effective on the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary surrender.

By voluntarily surrendering my license, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice medicine in the State of New Hampshire effective upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary surrender.
2. I admit that this license surrender has occurred in settlement of pending disciplinary charges arising out of an incident occurring on ~~August 6, 2012~~ ^{July 29, 2012} in which I, while licensed to practice medicine in New Hampshire, reported to work at Bridgton Hospital in Lewiston, Maine impaired and then hit a ~~mailbox~~ ^{wooden object} after leaving the hospital. 3. I admit to no violations of RSA 329:17, VI, but recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action.
4. Should I again seek licensure in the State of New Hampshire, I must meet and shall bear the burden of proving compliance with all of the standards and prerequisites then required by the Board for new applicants, including .

professional character requirements. Additionally, should I again seek licensure in the State of New Hampshire; I must enter into a contract with the New Hampshire Professionals Health Program, or its equivalent, for five (5) years and submit proof of compliance with the first year of that contract.

5. I understand that the pending disciplinary allegations shall be resolved in any future licensure application I may submit in New Hampshire. I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations.
6. I understand that if the Board chooses to accept my surrender of license, this document shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decision making specific finding of professional misconduct. I recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
7. I voluntarily submit this surrender of license to the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
