ORDER


On June 30, 2010, the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board") issued an Order of Emergency License Suspension and Notice of Hearing scheduling an emergency adjudicatory hearing for July 7, 2010. On July 7, 2010, the Board voted to accept a Joint Motion to Reconsider, continued the licensee's suspension for 120 days, and postponed the emergency hearing. On September 21, 2010, the Board issued a Notice of Hearing scheduling a full adjudicatory hearing on the merits for October 6, 2010.

On September 28, 2010, the Board received a Petition to Accept [a] Permanent Voluntary Surrender of License from Hearing Counsel together with a Permanent Voluntary Surrender of License signed by the licensee. As a result, and as a result of the pre-hearing conference on September 29, 2010, on October 6, 2010, the Board voted to "withdraw the Notice of Hearing, issued on September 21, 2010, from the public record."

Therefore, the September 21, 2010 Notice of Hearing is withdrawn. Of note, on October 6, 2010, the Board accepted the Permanent Voluntary Surrender of License (under separate order) alleviating the need for a full adjudicatory hearing.

PERMANENT VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board") concerning allegations of disruptive behavior, I, Lawrence A. Mazur, M.D., hereby voluntarily surrender my New Hampshire license (#7445) effective on the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary surrender.

By voluntarily surrendering my license, I understand that:


1. I permanently relinquish all rights and privileges to practice medicine in the State of New Hampshire effective upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary surrender.
2. I admit that this license surrender has occurred in settlement of pending disciplinary charges.
3. I admit to no violations of RSA 329:17, VI, but recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action.
4. I shall not reapply for licensure in the State of New Hampshire.
5. I understand that if the Board chooses to accept my surrender of license, this document shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decision making specific finding of professional misconduct. I recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action. I further understand that this



document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.

6. This permanent surrender, due to its binding nature, shall bar the issuance of any other disciplinary actions or sanctions based on the pending misconduct allegations, pursuant to RSA 329:17, VII. Additionally, this will fully and completely terminate the adjudicatory process and pending hearing on the misconduct allegations.
7. I voluntarily submit this surrender of license to the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
8. This surrender of license is contingent on the Board withdrawing the Notice of Hearing, issued on September 21, 2010, from the public record.
