Statement from Governor Hassan, Senate President Morse and Speaker Jasper on Burglary at State House

CONCORD – Governor Maggie Hassan, Senate President Chuck Morse and Speaker Shawn Jasper released the following statement today on the burglary under investigation at the State House:

"The State House is a repository to numerous treasures that tell the story of our history as a state and as a people. We are grateful that while there was some damage done in the course of this burglary, none of our treasures appear to be lost and none of the damage appears irreversible. We will provide additional information as the investigation progresses and after the damage is fully assessed.
