Governor Hassan's Statement Sustained Veto of SB 446

CONCORD – Following the New Hampshire State Senate sustaining her veto of Senate Bill 446, Governor Maggie Hassan issued the following statement:

“Ensuring that buildings in New Hampshire are safe is critical to public safety and our economy, and we must always work to ensure that our families and businesses have the safe environment necessary for them to grow and thrive. Senate Bill 446 would have made it more difficult for building inspectors to properly vet projects and ensure that applicants meet the necessary requirements to keep the public safe, which is why this bill was opposed by the New Hampshire Association of Fire Chiefs and the New Hampshire Planners Association and why the changes the bill proposed were not recommended by the State Building Code Review Board.”
