Governor Hassan Applauds Announcement of NSA Industries Expansion in Groveton

CONCORD – Governor Maggie Hassan issued the following statement on today's announcement that NSA Industries will expand operations to Groveton and bring at least 40 new jobs to a 73,000-square-foot facility at the former paper mill:

"Today's announcement by NSA Industries is exciting news that will spur economic development in the North Country, bring more good jobs to the region and boost manufacturing in New Hampshire. I commend the Department of Resources and Economic Development and New Hampshire Employment Security for working with the company to host job fairs and address workforce needs, and I thank NSA Industries for choosing to expand in New Hampshire – reinforcing that our low-tax environment, highly skilled workforce, small and responsive state government, and high quality of life make New Hampshire as attractive a state as any for businesses to lead in the innovation economy of the 21st century."

As NSA Industries considered expanding to Groveton, the New Hampshire Department of Resources and Economic Development (DRED) and New Hampshire Employment Security (NHES) worked to help the company address its workforce needs, hosting two job fairs coordinated by the NHES Berlin office that attracted approximately 300 job applicants. In addition, DRED worked to facilitate contact between NSA Industries and the New Hampshire Business Finance Authority, which is assisting with financing for the facility.

"This is great news and I thank NSA Industries for choosing to expand in Groveton," said state Senator Jeff Woodburn. "For far too long, we have seen manufacturing jobs leave us in the North Country, but today's announcement shows that we can bring good-paying manufacturing jobs back to our region. I also want to thank property owner Bob Chapman, the New Hampshire Departments of Resources and Economic Development and Employment Security for working so diligently with NSA Industries to demonstrate the benefits of relocating to New Hampshire's North Country. This is a great example of how a responsive state government can work closely with private industry to promote our great state and attract employers with our low taxes, skilled workforce, and high quality of life."
