Governor Hassan Announces Job Training Grants for Three New Hampshire Companies in October

Matching Grants Will Help Train 15 Workers in New Skills

CONCORD – Continuing her efforts to strengthen New Hampshire's workforce by helping workers develop the skills and innovative thinking needed for high-quality jobs in the 21st century economy, Governor Maggie Hassan announced today that three New Hampshire companies have received job training grants to help train 15 workers in new skills.

The job training grants this month total \$19,625, and the companies contributed matching funds to bring the total amount for training workers to \$39,250.

"I am proud to announce the latest round of these important job training grants, which are helping to boost our economy by equipping more workers with the skills needed for high-quality jobs at New Hampshire's innovative businesses," Governor Hassan said. "We must continue working together to strengthen our workforce pipeline through job training and higher education to build on our progress and to keep New Hampshire's economy moving in the right direction."

- **Belisle Machine Works of Manchester** received a grant of \$3,750 for two employees to receive training in ISO Collaborative through the New Hampshire Manufacturing Extension Partnership (NHMEP).
- A grant of up to \$5,375 was awarded to **Creare of Hanover** for 10 employees to receive Brazing training from Kay & Associates.
- **Solid Machine of Rochester** received a grant of \$10,500 to train three employees in ISO:2015 with the NHMEP.

The Job Training Fund has awarded \$9,248,479 in grants since October 2007, with employers contributing \$12,064,037 for a total of \$21,312,516 in new training for 26,707 New Hampshire workers.
