Governor Hassan's Statement on November Unemployment Rate

CONCORD - Governor Maggie Hassan issued the following statement today on the announcement that the unemployment rate in New Hampshire decreased to 2.7 percent in November:

"The decrease in New Hampshire's unemployment rate for November indicates that our economy continues to move in the right direction, a clear sign of the bipartisan progress that we have made together in New Hampshire over the last several years. While our unemployment rate was the lowest in the nation for October and will remain among the lowest in the nation for November at 2.7 percent, we know that there is still more work to do to support hard-working Granite Staters and our job-creating businesses. I look forward to continue working across party lines to help all Granite Staters access high-quality jobs, support our growing, innovative businesses and expand middle class opportunity so that all of our people who work hard have the opportunity to get ahead and stay ahead."
