

The New Hampshire State Council on the Arts (NHSCA) is a state agency within the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources. Grants and services offered by NHSCA enhance the quality of life in New Hampshire by stimulating economic growth, investing in the creativity of students and improving academic outcomes, making the arts accessible to underserved populations, and preserving heritage arts.

The Council's grant categories are designed to meet constituent needs and serve as a public investment in communities throughout the state. Grants are competitive and require applicants to address specific criteria, exemplify high standards of excellence in artistry and administration, and leverage private sector support in the form of matching funds, goods and services.

Grants are awarded through a combination of state and federal (<u>National Endowment for the Arts</u>) funds. Applications are adjudicated through a peer panel review process, based upon the concept of public input on the expenditure of public funds. Individuals with relevant art form and/or arts practice expertise serve as panelists for each category. Panelists review applications and work samples and evaluate them based upon published criteria.

In FY 2018, 103 grants were awarded in the following categories: <u>Artist Residencies in Schools</u>; <u>Arts in Health</u>; <u>Cultural Conservation (Mooseplates)</u>; <u>General Projects for Community Engagement</u>; <u>Poetry Out Loud</u>; <u>Public Value Partnerships</u>; <u>Traditional Arts Apprenticeships</u>; and <u>Youth Arts Projects</u>.


This profile provides a statistical snapshot of the agency's grant investments in FY 2018. The grant total of \$555,730 was **48%** of the agency's fiscal year spending, well above the National Endowment for the Arts' mandate. These investments leveraged over \$1 million in in-kind goods and services, and **over \$43 million in income** by grantee organizations and projects.
