All workshops are 2 hours in length. Proposals should address one or more of the workshop goals:

- Model projects in any discipline that support arts competencies in the [National Core Arts Standards](#), including Arts Integration
- Innovative teaching practices
- Curriculum units that encourage innovative, creative, and critical thinking in youth
- Artist in Residence programs or out of school learning opportunities that provide access to the arts for underserved youth, Pre-K to 12
- Documenting, evaluating, or assessing arts learning
- Models of STEAM projects (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts, Math)
- Programs that increase technology and media opportunities in the arts
- Using the Arts to enhance Individual Education Plans (IEPs)

To submit a proposal [fill out this google form](#) with the following information by September 4, 2017:

- Names and contact information for all presenters in your group
- Proposed workshop title
- 2-3 sentence workshop description
- Full workshop description (2 paragraphs max)
- Link to website or work samples (photos, video, etc.)
- Maximum number of people in your workshop
- Any special workshop requirements (wifi, tables, chairs, etc.)
- 1 paragraph addressing how your workshop relates to the theme: Teaching Innovation & Creativity.

All workshop presenters are required to attend the full conference and will receive a stipend and complimentary registration. Workshop proposals will be selected by a conference advisory committee working to create a well-rounded multidisciplinary conference. You will be notified if your proposal has been selected by September 19, 2017.
