Lodging

& Conference Cost Sheet

This document includes:

- a cost sheet for commuters and overnight guests;
- descriptions of Harris Center lodging; and
- a list of alternate lodging options.

There are three conference housing options at the Barbara Harris Center. All of the lodging is rustic, designed to provide guests with a natural setting that encourages a sense of community, a feeling of relaxation and opportunities for reflection and renewal.

All accommodations are shared; no private rooms are available. All cabins are heated and winterized. Please see note below in case you prefer to find your own lodging nearby.

Family Cabins



The standard cabins are nestled in the woods overlooking Otter Lake. Each cabin has five sets of bunk beds and a bathroom with two toilets, sinks and showers. (Note: for our conference, no registrants will be required to sleep in an upper bunk.)

Decks on each cabin invite guests to gather together and enjoy the center's natural beauty. Guests provide their own bedding, towels and toiletries. Linen can be rented for an additional \$12.

“Adult” Cabins



Each fall, ten of the traditional cabins are converted to “adult friendly”. Each cabin features four twin beds, furniture, and hotel-style amenities. Bedding and towels are provided.

Bunkhouse



Renovated in the spring of 2013, the new bunkhouse sleeps 16 in two separate sleeping rooms overlooking beautiful Otter Lake. Each room has 4 sets of bunk beds fitted with twin-sized mattresses. There are two bathrooms each with two showers, sinks and toilets. The fireplaced living

room features a kitchenette equipped with a full size refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker and toaster. A screened porch provides views of the sunrise and sunset over Otter Lake. Guests provide their own bedding, towels and toiletries. Linens can be rented for \$12.
