Transitional Housing Unit Resident Placed on Escape Status

(Manchester, NH) – June 21, 2022 – The New Hampshire Department of Corrections announced today that a minimum-security resident CLIFTON R. CARON JR. of the Calumet Correctional Institution in Manchester has been placed on ESCAPE status, after failing to return to the Calumet Correctional Institution on June 20, 2022.

Mr. Caron was last seen around 9:00 A.M. on June 20, 2022, at the Calumet Correctional Institution when he signed out for work and was traveling to his home in Manchester. Mr. Caron is expected to return to the Calumet Correctional Institution at 10:30 P.M.

Mr. Caron is a 35-year-old Black male, 5'9" tall, 170 lbs, brown eyes, and black hair. He was last seen wearing a black t-shirt, black pants, black sneakers with black socks, and a black select backpack.

Mr. Caron is incarcerated in the Calumet Correctional Institution with a minimum parole eligibility date of July 22, 2022.
