### **PAUL RAYMOND, JR. SWORN-IN AS ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER**

**Concord, NH** – Among family, friends and colleagues, Paul Raymond, Jr. of Concord was sworn-in as the Department of Corrections' Assistant Commissioner on September 12, 2022.

On Wednesday, September 7, 2022, the New Hampshire Executive Council unanimously confirmed the appointment of Raymond, as Assistant Commissioner at the New Hampshire Department of Corrections. Governor Sununu nominated Raymond on August 17, 2022.

“I am excited to welcome Paul Raymond into this new leadership role in the Department,” said Commissioner Helen Hanks. “Since his first appointment as the Director of Personnel and Information, Paul has been leading key lines of effort including the bureaus of human resources, employee training and development, communications, and business information.
