TRANSITIONAL HOUSING UNIT RESIDENT PLACED ON ESCAPE STATUS

(Manchester, NH) –The New Hampshire Department of Corrections announces that minimum-security resident JASON PEDRO #140986 of the Calumet Transitional Housing Unit in Manchester has been placed on ESCAPE status as of 10:15 PM on Tuesday, December 6, 2022, after he failed to return to the Calumet House following his scheduled off-site work shift.

Mr. Pedro was last seen Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at 5:30 PM on Maple Street in Manchester, NH. Mr. Pedro was traveling by foot and was scheduled to return to the Calumet House at 7:00 PM.

Mr. Pedro is described as a 37-year-old white male, 5’8”, and weighing 215 lbs. He has hazel eyes and brown hair. He has a light mustache but could be growing a beard. Pedro was last seen wearing khaki-colored pants, a dark grey jacket, khaki-colored boots, and a dark-colored winter hat, and was carrying a grey backpack.

Mr. Pedro is incarcerated for robbery with a minimum parole eligibility date of December 26, 2022 and a current maximum release date of December 25, 2024.
