**NH DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS JOINS VINE**

**Concord, NH** –The New Hampshire Department of Corrections is pleased to announce its launch of the New Hampshire Victim Information and Notification Everyday platform, also known as New Hampshire VINE.

VINE is a free and confidential service that provides survivors and victims of crime with access to timely information about any changes to an offender’s incarceration status within the State of New Hampshire correctional system.

“Keeping survivors and victims of crime informed is about safety,” said New Hampshire Department of Corrections Commissioner Helen Hanks. “As a victim-centered and trauma-informed organization, VINE allows the department to better support and assist survivors and victims in New Hampshire by sharing the essential information they need in a timely, confidential, and person-centered way.”

“VINE reaffirms our commitment to keeping victims and survivors safe and informed,” said Governor Chris Sununu. “This was a top priority and I commend the Department of Corrections for diligently working to launch this effort.”

Through VINE, concerned individuals can feel safer and more informed by accessing services through the VINE website, 24-hour toll-free number, and mobile app. Users have the option of anonymously registering to receive automated notifications delivered by telephone, e-mail, or text message. Notifications will be sent whenever there is a change in the status of an incarcerated individual, including their release, parole, and transfer.
