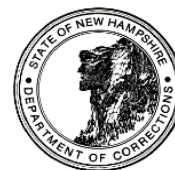

## **Transitional Housing Resident on “Escape” Status**

May 8, 2019 - (Concord, NH) - The New Hampshire Department of Corrections (NHDOC) announces that a minimum-security resident of the New Hampshire State Prison’s North End Transitional Housing Unit in Concord, NH has been placed on “escape” status as of 9:10 p.m. Tuesday night. Scott Gagne, 29, failed to return to the transitional housing unit at the agreed upon time of 8:00 p.m.

Gagne is described as a white male, 5’9”, 160 pounds with brown hair and brown eyes. He was sentenced to prison for felony willful concealment and felony controlled drug/acts prohibited. He was eligible for parole in December 2019.

Escaping from a transitional housing unit could result in a Class B felony punishable by 3 ½ - 7 years in prison.
