## Transitional Housing Resident on “Escape” Status

April 26, 2019 - (Concord, NH) - The New Hampshire Department of Corrections (NHDOC) announces that a minimum-security resident of the New Hampshire State Prison’s Calumet Transitional Housing Unit in Manchester, NH has been placed on “escape” status as of 11:30 a.m. Friday morning. Bradley Tyrrell, 55, failed to show up at Calumet Transitional Housing Unit after work, as required. He was last seen on Ross Ave. in Manchester.

Tyrrell is described as a white male, 5’6”, 145 pounds with brown hair and blue eyes. He began serving a 1 to 2-year sentence in 2018 for felony theft.

Anyone with information on Tyrrell’s whereabouts should call the NHDOC Investigations Bureau at 271-1860, New Hampshire State Police or your local law enforcement agency.

Escaping from a transitional housing unit could result in a Class B felony punishable by 3 ½ - 7 years in prison.
