

- visit, as well as, possible termination of future visits.
- 2) Inmates and visitors will be permitted to hold hands on top of a table. Holding hands under a table is strictly prohibited and will result in the immediate termination of the visit, as well as possible future visitation.
 - 3) Inmates and visitors shall maintain a visible physical space between each person while seated at the tables. The failure to comply with this requirement will result in the immediate termination of the visit, as well as, possible termination of future visits.
 - 4) All vending machines and board games will be removed from the visiting rooms.

In closing, we will continue to investigate the illegal use, sale, and introduction of illegal drugs in our prison facilities. While I appreciate and understand the importance of being able to visit with your family and friends, it is our responsibility to protect the safety of all inmates, as well as, DOC staff and the public. It is unfortunate that some individuals want to continue their criminal ways by undermining our best efforts to keep you all safe. It is my expectation by implementing these changes there will be a noticeable reduction in the amount of drugs being introduced and used in our facilities. If I do not see positive results from these changes, we are prepared to take whatever additional steps are necessary to prevent drugs from being introduced into our institutions.
